

AFF'S INDUCTION TEST DETAILS

Weightage:

- 60% English (including GK, Vocabulary, idioms, analogies, case study and critical reasoning)
- 40% Technical (accounts, audit, and taxation).
- Paragraph writing separately (that would be assessed only if you meet the required cut off from above 2 portions)

GK questions which I am able to recall now:

- Year of establishment of AFF
- AFF - full form
- NATO's head office location
- Developer of Law of natural selection
- Reasons for first world war
- Oldest search engine (amongst MSN, Yahoo, Ask.com & Google)
- Free market definition
- Name of one of the countries (Eritrea) was given and we were asked to which continent does it belong?
- Islam was stated as state religion in which constitution of Pak?
- Ek koi international bank thi, uska function/purpose phocha hua tha.

AFF's 1st interview:

- Briefly introduce yourself
- Your journey in CA so far
- Extracurricular, if any (if you narrate any, then were you able to win anything? They might ask the details of a particular one)
- Concept behind deferred tax
- One of the questions related to cost of material (Should taxes be made part of the cost of material if a raw material is procured by the company ?)
- How's your GK?
- Would you like to share some info with us? Any recent info about which you are aware of. (It's a type of question where you are expected to reply positively)

AFF's 2nd Interview:

- If you are given 2 minutes to analyze yourself, can you identify your strengths and weaknesses? (It is very probable that they would raise further questions regarding one of your strengths/weaknesses specified)
- Do you have an idea about post balance sheet events?
- Examples of adjusting and non-adjusting events
- Do you read newspaper? (Clearly state a 'no' if you don't read it otherwise you would be asked to shed light on that particular day's headline or any news that you would have read before coming for interview or to be precise, you may be asked to share your views regarding a particular news in that day's newspaper)
- In case of no to newspaper related question, then how do you keep yourself updated with the current affairs ?
- What are the qualities that a chartered accountant must possess (You'd get to know about this while

studying ethics in audit. Jbtw, integrity and honesty come before everything)

- Why do you consider that a chartered accountant must have the specified quality? (Logical justification is mandatory)
- What is qualified audit report?
- You may be asked from the topic which is outside the scope of your syllabus. (Unless you know the answer and can justify your answer, communicate that it was not in our syllabus)
- You may be asked to answer questions which you were unable to answer in your 1st interview,
- You may be asked to explain the point which you briefly/concisey mentioned while submitting your form. (Remember whatever you communicate, must not be contrary to the details provided by you at the time of submitting form, they do have your form in-front of them and they may confirm the information being communicated with the details mentioned in your form)
- Rate your interview on a scale of 10
